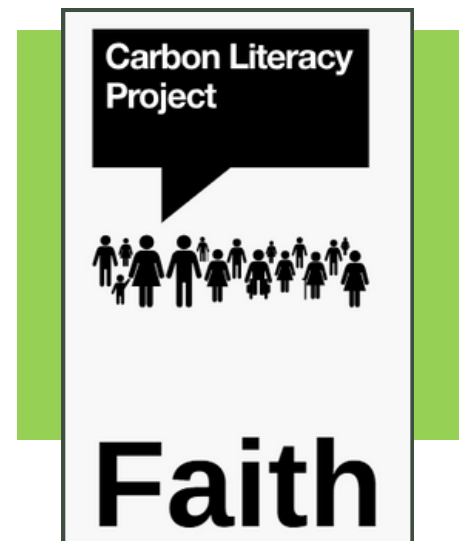
A new Carbon Literacy Course has just been launched:  
**Carbon Literacy for Christian Congregations.**

This ecumenical course is designed for use in church settings such as home groups, Lent courses, or church away days. It sets the carbon literacy training in a faith context. The course includes a leader's handbook, and a participant's handbook, and uses a variety of exercises and discussion to cover the material.

Course leaders need a short briefing from the Carbon Literacy project before running the course.

The course is free, but there is a £15 cost per person to be accredited by the Carbon Literacy project. Different denominations will have different invoicing arrangements which can be discussed in the briefing with the CLP. For more information visit:
